## Program Director's Report:

The final total for our Pennies for Heaven campaign was \$300 + top-up of \$100 from our council, providing a \$400 donation. Thanks to all who contributed.

At the June council meeting, we voted to add \$220 to our St. Michael's food bank donation, giving \$1000 total for the year. This was submitted to State to qualify for a \$200 rebate.

We also voted to pay \$300 to the caterer of the teachers' luncheon.

In July, with the approval of our executive, our council donated \$300 for the BC forest fire fund. Money raised was sent to Bishop Joseph in Kamloops for the forest fire victims.

Charity Appeal 50/50 draw, Summer 2021 ended July 12, 2021. The total collected was \$40,675 and so the winner, Larry Woods of Williams Lake, BC, took home \$20,337.50. The other half went to support our Bishops with their various programs in their diocese. Thanks to all who support this fund-raiser by buying tickets.

As you can see above our Pancake Breakfasts will have to be on-hold for now due to the 4<sup>th</sup> wave of the pandemic. Also our usual Parish Feast Day dinner / dance has been cancelled.
